This notice is for all those of you who currently gift aid your donations to KMC.

Firstly, note that if you have changed your address since you completed your Gift Aid form or the old Deed of Covenant form, you do need to complete a new Gift Aid declaration please. If you think this does apply to you please let me know.

Secondly, you as donors do need to be sure that the amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax you pay in any tax year does exceed the amount of Gift Aid that is claimed on your donations. Should there be a difference it is your responsibility to pay it. If you are unsure of your position here please let me know and we can discuss it further as appropriate. It follows of course that if you no longer pay tax you cannot Gift Aid so again if this applies to you let me know.
