Meeting at Trinity Methodist – 9th May 7.45pm

We are very fortunate to welcome Mr Michael Poole, (visiting Research Fellow in Science and Religion, King's College, London), to our Circuit on Wednesday 9th May. At 7.45pm he will be speaking at Trinity Methodist Church, Woking on "Christianity and the New Atheism". Mike Poole trained as a physicist and taught for fourteen years at a South London Boys Comprehensive School where he became Head of Physics. Three years preparing and broadcasting radio programmes on science-and-religion for overseas audiences followed. He then joined the full-time staff of King's College London as Lecturer in Physics/Science Education with research interests in the interplay between science and religion, with special reference to education. He introduced a 30 hour Master's level module in Science and Religion and has recently retired from his Visiting Research Fellowship in Science and Religion at King's College. He is the author of several books and some eighty papers and articles on science and religion for science teachers, religious education specialists and a general readership.
