Walk Through the Bible

The next step in our "Walking tour through the Bible" is on Tuesday 22nd May at 8pm in the Hall at St Hugh of Lincoln, Knaphill, and tackles the third book of the Bible, Leviticus. This is the book that contains the verse 'If a man lies with a male as with a woman, both of them shall be put to death for their abominable deed; they have forfeited their lives' (20:13). While much of Leviticus, with its various rules and regulations, may not have much to say to us, this verse (along with 18:22) is certainly much discussed. Do have a look through the book if you can before the meeting, at which we shall try to discover what the book means for us today. For future meetings we will be joined by our Methodist minister, Rev David Faulkner, who has a deep knowledge of Holy Scripture, and will open up for us the Book of Deuteronomy (19th June); and Fr Simon Hall from St Dunstan's who is going to talk about the Book of Judges (on 3rd July). Numbers and Joshua will be led by Fr Alexander on 12th and 26th June respectively. All are invited, all are welcome.
