Jane Ing wanted to share this with you: Feeding the Homeless at Waterloo Bridge, London

Earlier this month, I went to Waterloo Bridge in London to help feed the homeless with a member of Knaphill Holy Trinity Church (the organiser), my son, my husband and other volunteers. Train fares and all the food were paid for, but there was a voluntary £5 donation for those wishing to pay.

We took with us, 4 huge suitcases, a few rucksacks, 36 litres of hot water, plus tea, coffee, milk, soup, boxes of cakes and biscuits. As we reached our destination we were met by more volunteers and queues of homeless people were waiting for us. We set up as quickly as we could to help with hot drinks and soup, then mingled with the crowd, giving out sandwiches and cakes. It was obvious to see that the homeless have a great relationship with the organiser and his team. We were met with smiles and most were chatty, their backgrounds extremely diverse, yet everyone got on very well. I can't begin to tell you what a fantastic evening we had. God's presence was strong.

More volunteers are needed to ensure this great work continues. If you, your friends, family members or work colleagues can spare some time for this good cause, please let me know and I will tell you more about it. The more people who volunteer will allow there to be a rota so that the small team won't feel obliged to go every week as they do now. Volunteers can get as involved as they wish.
